#### **Amber Warning**

On Monday and Tuesday next week we are anticipating very warm temperatures which may impact how the school functions.

As it stands there is an amber warning for the Northwest. The latest summary reads:

- The heat begins to build from Saturday onwards with day-on-day rises in temperature through to Tuesday. Temperatures on Saturday pleasantly warm, mid 20°c Cheshire.
- Sunday very warm/hot, high 20s°c Cheshire with perhaps the odd spot 30°c in S. Cheshire.
- Night time temperatures will become increasingly uncomfortable from Saturday night onwards. Sunday night may not dip below 20°c in town centres and there will be little or no breeze.
- On Monday the temperatures will rise into the 30s °c with peak values reaching as high as the mid 30s °c Cheshire.
- Monday night is expected to be very warm and oppressive (expected to be in the mid 20s °c).
- The peak of the heat will be Tuesday when it is likely to hit mid 30s °c. It is possible for some spots to reach the upper 30s °c
- The breakdown of the heatwave is currently scheduled for Tuesday night into Wednesday with an increasing likelihood of thundery showers spreading up from the southwest

If the forecasts are accurate then the school will be putting additional measures in place such to protect the children. These measures may include reduced time outside, additional hydration breaks etc. It is vital that ALL children attend with a waterbottle next week to ensure that they have access to water when needed. A hat and suncream is also very strongly advised.

#### Met Office

Thursday to Saturday - generally warm and settled, temperatures gradually build from Saturday.

Sunday - temperatures reaching into low- to mid-30s Celsius inland in warmest areas.

Monday and Tuesday - peak in temperatures. reaching mid- to high-30s in places.

40% chance of breaking all-time UK records.

20% chance of 40 Celsius being recorded somewhere in the UK.

Some places seeing minimum temperatures remaining above 20 Celsius, especially so in urban areas.

Outside the warning area, temperatures also well above average.

From Wednesday onwards - general cooling trend towards more normal temperatures for the time of year. A risk of showers or thunderstorms developing.
